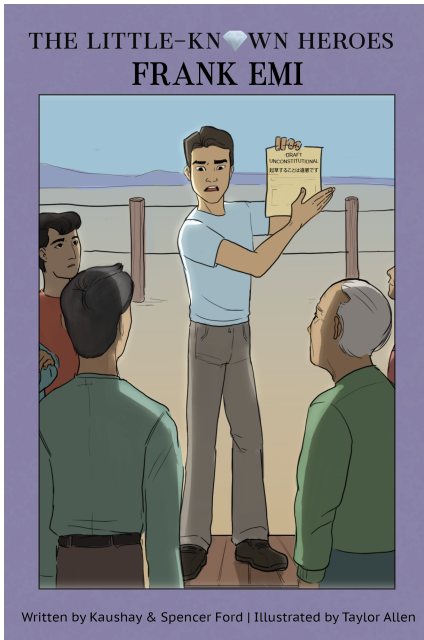


THE LITTLE-KNOWN HEROES: FRANK EMI
