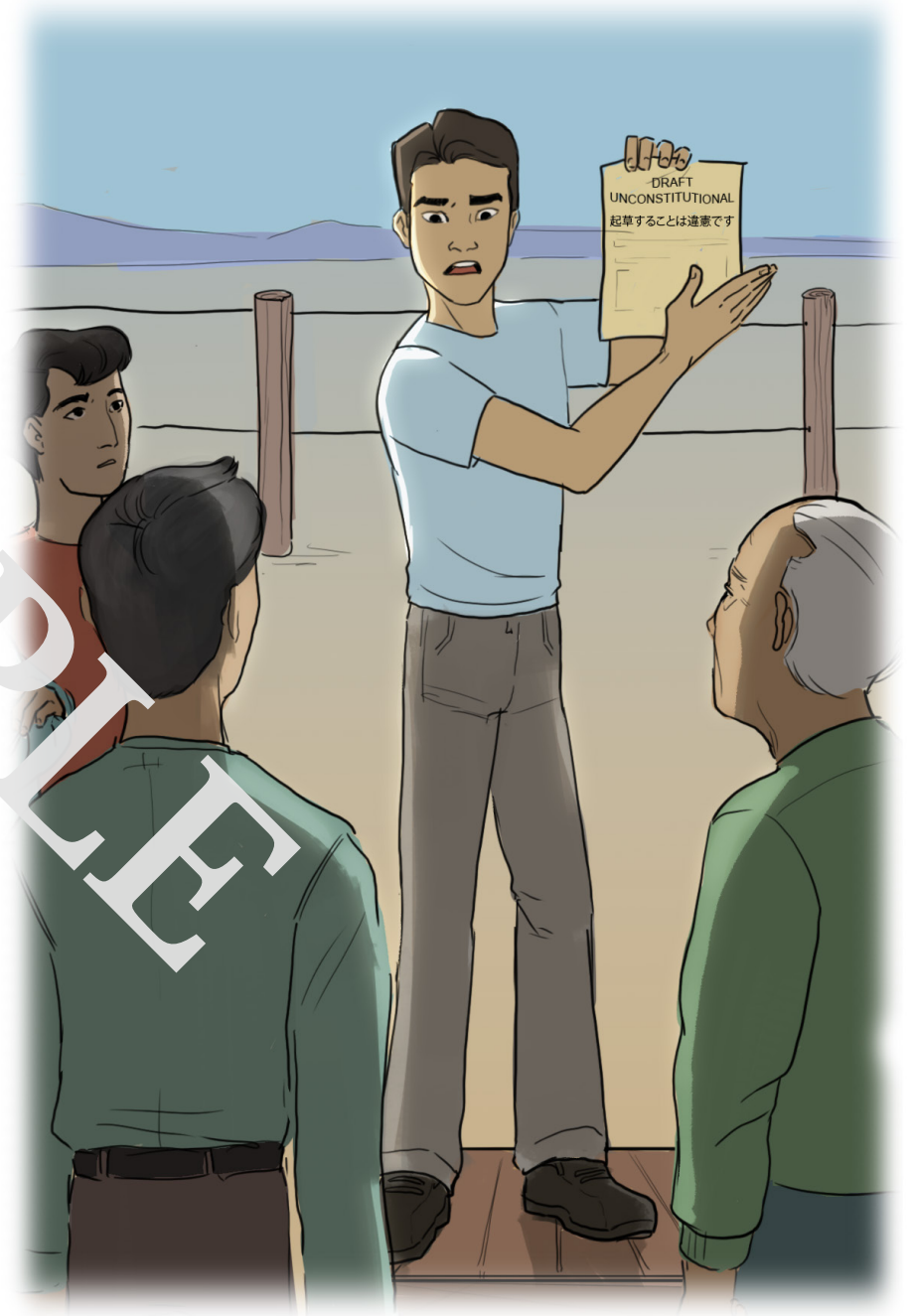
Thank you for reading with your child! The Little-Known Heroes series was designed for parents and children to read together, with three purposes in mind:
